Community Consulting Teams of Boston Awards a Consulting Project Grant to Boston Post Adoption Resources

Community Consulting Teams of Boston (CCT) has selected Boston Post Adoption Resources (BPAR) as one of its 10 pro bono management consulting projects for 2023. CCT has awarded consulting grants to more than 200 Boston-area nonprofits since its inception in 1990, providing an estimated \$25 million value. BPAR was chosen among Boston-area nonprofits based on its demonstrated need, organizational stability, and readiness to plan and implement change. The CCT project will include stakeholder and peer analyses to provide strategic recommendations BPAR can use to expand the education component of their mission with an online Learning Center.

Since 2012, Boston Post Adoption Resources has been providing adoption competent therapy to individuals touched by adoption. They connect people to post adoption resources and educate the public about the impacts of adoption. Through their services, BPAR invites those touched by adoption to join their community in an environment that encourages lifelong healing. The need for their services continues to grow.
